Subject: Coachella Valley PEV Readiness Plan

Recommendation: Approval of Draft Coachella Valley PEV Readiness Plan

<u>Background</u>: In June of 2012, CVAG executed an agreement with the California Energy Commission to prepare a Coachella Valley Plug-in Electric (PEV) Vehicle Readiness Plan. CVAG hired ICF International to prepare that plan and they have been working on the document for the past year. Dr. Philip Sheehy is the ICF staff person who is leading the work.

At your Nov. 14, 2013 meeting you were told that the draft Plan was ready for review and that you would be electronically sent the document. On Nov. 20, CVAG staff distributed the PEV Readiness plan to CVPEVCC members.

On Wednesday, Dec. 11, the PEV Readiness Plan Technical Working Group, consisting of local city staff members and interested persons, met to discuss the draft Plan. Staff received some very good comments that are being incorporated into the Plan. The updated version will be ready in early January. That document will be posted on our website at www.cvag.org and a link will be created on the home page. The document will be ready for access on Monday, January 6.

Dr. Sheehy will be at the meeting to answer questions.
