5. <u>COMMITTEE MEMBER / DIRECTOR COMMENTS</u>

Tom Kirk reported that the CVCC has received Section 6 federal funding grant in the amount of \$2 million that will be used to acquire open space in the Plan area. Assemblyman Eduardo Garcia is the author of Proposition 68 – the Parks, Environment and Water Bond –was approved by the voters on June 5. As a result, the Coachella Valley Mountains Conservancy will receive \$7 million. There will be \$52 million available for Natural Community Conservation Planning (NCCP's) to help meet the requirements of the state program. There will be \$200 million available for the Salton Sea and \$1.3 million available for the parks and recreation program tied to disadvantaged communities.
