A. Annual Point-in-Time Count of Homeless Individuals

Deputy Director Tanya Torno from Riverside County Housing and Workforce Solutions' presented an overview of the Annual Point-in-Time (PIT) Count of Homelessness Individuals study conducted for 2023. Director Torno detailed the trends and factors c contributing to homelessness, according to the study.

Extensive member discussion ensued. Councilmember Holstege requested a breakdown by city of the Continuum of Care numbers from the PIT report for CVAG's jurisdiction. Staff noted a breakdown will be provided in the next Homelessness Committee meeting agenda.

No action was taken as this was an information item.

B. Presentation on Riverside County's Homeless Action Plan

Due to time constraints, this item was moved to be presented at the June Homelessness Committee meeting.

C. Landlord Incentive Program for Increasing Available Units

Ms. Erica Felci presented the proposed Landlord Incentive Program to the committee.

Member discussion ensued, with Management Analyst Ivan Tenorio and Ms. Felci both addressing the committee questions. Staff committed to providing an update on how the program is working at a future meeting.
