5. CHAIR / COMMITTEE MEMBER/CVAG STAFF COMMENTS

Assistant Executive Director Erica Felci welcomed the committee back to in-person meetings in the CVAG conference room and detailed the Zoom logistics available for meetings.

Chair Fermon commented on the end of festival season, with Coachella and Stagecoach wrapping up in April. Chair Fermon updated the committee with statistics of arrests during festivals, and commented that the numbers were down compared to previous years.

6. EX-OFFICIO COMMENTS

Palm Springs Police Captain Mike Kovaleff gave an update of their crime trends, including numbers that report an overall reduction of 6% in crime in 2022 compared to previous years.

Desert Hot Springs Deputy Chief Steve Shaw noted they had a hiccup in their reporting system in 2022, but provided crime trends to date in 2023.

Chief Deputy District Attorney Rodney Tethal provided additional insights on the nexus between crime trends and the dismissal of cases taking countywide, including those due to backlogs and unavailable courtrooms.

Cathedral City Fire Chief Michael Contreras updated the Committee on response times from AMR ambulances and related challenges with staffing.

Incoming Palm Springs Fire Chief Paul Alvarado made introductory remarks.

8. DISCUSSION / ACTION

A. School Resource Officers in the Coachella Valley

Assistant Executive Director Erica Felci provided an overview of the staff report including a breakdown of the two different models that the valley's three school districts use for campus security.

Extensive member discussion ensued with a focus on understanding Coachella Valley Unified School District's decision to not use school resource officers. Staff noted that CVUSD had been invited to attend.

Desert Sands Unified's Jordan Aquino, Assistant Superintendent of Business Services, and Ryan Chandler, security manager, provided information on their school resource officers and addressed members' questions.

Members expressed varying opinions on whether to weigh in on the matter, which had been a request from the City of La Quinta. Ms. Felci said staff would follow up again with CVUSD to try to address questions and get additional data.

No vote was taken, and the Committee members asked staff to gather more information and statistics before bringing the item back for discussion.

B. Roundtable Discussion of Coachella Valley Crime Trends

Chair Fermon noted that many reports had been provided during the ex officio update.

Cathedral City Commander Rick Sanchez reported the City saw a significant decrease in m, any areas, but saw an uptick in robberies and crimes of opportunity in 2022.
