ADDENDUM

Addendum Date: February 13, 2026

Purpose: This addendum supplements, amends, and takes precedence over the original Request for Proposals (RFP) and shall be considered when preparing proposals and shall become part of the Contract documents. Offerors shall review the Addendum work and requirements in detail and incorporate any effects the Addendum may have into their scope of services and cost proposal.

Note: All requirements of the RFP documents remain unchanged except as cited herein.

Questions & Requests:

The following are responses to the questions received by the Coachella Valley Association of Governments (CVAG) as of the deadline for receiving questions by 2:00 p.m. on February 12, 2026.

1. **Question:** Can the total number of pages for the technical proposal be increased from 10 to 25? Due to the amount of information requested, I'm not confident we can provide it in 10 pages + appendices.

Response: Yes, CVAG will increase the total number of pages for the Technical Proposal from 10 to 25 pages.

2. **Question:** Can you please confirm an electronic signature will be sufficient for this requirement?

Response: Yes, CVAG will accept electronic signatures on the Cover Letter.

3. **Question:** Should a contractor have a similar traffic signal maintenance contract with one of the CVAG agencies, would this prevent them from being selected for this contract?

Response: *No, it would not prevent consideration of the Contractor's proposal nor if selected, proceeding with contract finalization.*

4. **Question:** If exceptions are taken and noted, is the city willing to negotiate terms and conditions with an awarded contractor?

Response: *Yes, CVAG will review noted exceptions taken to its standard Professional Services Agreement and work in good faith with the selected contractor to resolve.*

5. **Question:** Should this be awarded to multiple contractors, would the \$100,000 annually be divided equally between them?

Response: *No, it is CVAG's intent to budget \$100,000 for each selected contractor(s) contingent on the available budget and which is in CVAG's best interest.*

6. **Question:** Will the contractor be responsible for storing any material?

Response: *No.*

7. **Question:** If material is held by CVAG, is the contractor able to charge hourly rates for employee & vehicle to pick up parts from CVAG storage location?

Response: *Yes.*

8. **Question:** What is the response time for emergency service response?

Response: *Expected response time is within two (2) hours of contractor receiving call.*

9. **Question:** Is the contractor able to charge hourly rates for employee & vehicle for required CV Sync Training?

Response: *Yes.*

10. **Question:** Does the hourly rates for employee/vehicle start from when the call is received?

Response: *Hourly rates begin when employee/vehicle is in route to location.*

11. **Question:** Can you provide a current pricing list from CVAG's current contractor?

Response: *No.*

The deadline to receive proposals remains no later than 2:00 p.m. on February 25, 2026.
